WHAT ARE MY RIGHTS?

- All people deserve clean air - in homes, schools, offices, etc.
- By law, homes must be weather-tight and water-tight.
- Bathrooms must be thoroughly ventilated to allow proper air flow.



HOW CAN I USE THESE RIGHTS TO PROTECT MY HEALTH?

- If you are a tenant and find mold in your unit, report it immediately to your landlord.
- If the problem is still not addressed, there are several steps you can take:
 1. Contact your town health inspector
 2. Pull together a community group to confront those who are harming your health, and demand action
 3. If no action is taken by your landlord or business owner, contact legal aid for representation
